> Internship

- Visit of Delegates –
- I. The Secretary of the Sangrahalaya, Professor Supriya Munshi was invited by the Institute of Foreign Policy Studies, University of Calcutta to deliver a lecture at the crash course on the Study India Programme for students from Nepal under the 'Bharat-Nepal Shiksha Maitri Karyakram'. This course was arranged by the University of Calcutta from 1st to 25th November, 2014. During this course period the Participants visited the Sangrahalaya for practical demonstration on 22nd November, 2014.
