A two days' Exhibition on Mahatma Gandhi's 18 points of Communal Structures for Reconstruction of Society, entitled 'India of My Dreams' and on 'Mahatma Gandhi -The Millennium Man' consisting of roll-upstandee panels were set up at the auditorium of the Sangrahalaya. The inaugural programme was started by the opening song, performed by a renowned singer Shri Pritam Chakraborty. 




Publication of the Sangrahalaya on the occasion of 150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi in 2019:


The Sangrahalaya published a Souvenir, composed of various articles related to Mahatma Gandhi's Life and activities and the souvenir would be distributed freely to the audience.


