## Book Released Programme at the Stall of Gandhi Smarak Sangrahalaya in 47<sup>th</sup> International Kolkata Book Fair (21.01.2024):

Gandhi Smarak Sangrahalaya had released two popular books on Mahatma Gandhi in Bengali, which were unavailable for last few years in the evening of January 21, 2024 at their Exhibition-cum-Book Stall at the 47<sup>th</sup> International Kolkata Book Fair ground. The books were translated and edited by late Padma Bhushan Shri Sailesh Kumar Bandopadhyay.
