Outreach Programme at Khelaghar, North 24 Parganas (06.04.2019):

Gandhi Smarak Sangrahalaya, Barrackpore reached at an institution named 'Khelaghar', located in a small village called Badu in North 24 Parganas district. Khelaghar is a secular, charitable trust and welfare home and education resource center. It provides shelter, food and education free of cost to "Children in need and in distress". This home was formed by Late Maitraye Devi, a well known writer, social worker and an ardent follower of Rabindranath Tagore, in 1971. Set amidst the beauty of the village green, Khelaghar blends with its background and harmonizes with the flowing life around it.

The Sangrahalaya organized an outreach programme at that place for the children of that institution. A documentary film on Indian Freedom Movement was shown to the children. They also participated in the audio-visual spot quiz programme on life & activities of Mahatma Gandhi, conducted by the Director-Secretary of the Sangrahalaya.
